The session I observed consisted of four parts: a short video, a student presentation, an explanation of the final project and a period where students put finishing touches on their Totem Project due at the end of the observed class session. The class seemed always to follow, to be listening and to understand the effort that was being asked of them. The instructor was clear and enthusiastic. He seemed to be enjoying his relationship with the students and the material.

**Organization and Clarity**: Excellent. Course documents and classroom management all reflect an complete awareness of the need for organization and clarity. Of particular note, the extremely well conceived explanation of the final project which helped the students, through multiple examples of both good and bad work from the past, to understand the challenge that faces them.

Enthusiasm: Excellent. Unflagging.

**Subject-Matter Expertise**: Seemed masterful to me, the non-artist. John had helpful discussions with most of the students while they were working on their projects. The students appeared to value his input.

**Rapport with Students**: The students appeared to value John's input and to be comfortable in their creative process.

**Student Evaluations**: Exemplary. An average of 4.67 out of 5 and no measure below 4.31. A very satisfied group of students to be sure.
